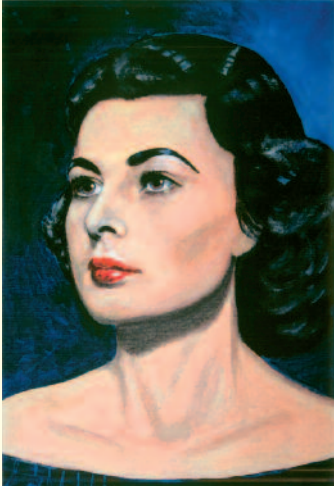

donation from the sale of a painting to add to the total of the raffle.

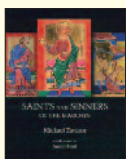
